WHAT DOES CALVARY AND THE TOMB TEACH US?

Matthew 27:31-28:17

Context: The Gospel of Matthew is written to the Jewish people to show witness to the evidence that Jesus is their Messiah (the Anointed and Promised Deliverer) and God the King.

You are urged to embrace the powerful death and empty tomb of Jesus as your full hope of Deliverance.

The Death and Resurrection of Christ shows us:

1. He could face a criminal's death for your sins (Matthew 27:31-38; Isaiah 53:4-6).

2. You may reject believing that He is your Savior and the Son of God (Matthew 27:39-41).

3. God the Father had to condemn Jesus for your sins (Matthew 27:45-50).
 - A. Deep Darkness, a symbol of God's judgment (Matthew 27:45; 2 Corinthians 5:21; Galatians 3:13).

 - B. Forsaken by God (Matthew 27:46).

 - C. In control of His death (Matthew 27:50; John 19:30).

4. The miracles at Calvary show He offers access to God, and His death is powerful (Matthew 27:51-56).

5. His burial evidenced His full humiliation to the point of death (Matthew 27:57-61; Philippians 2:7-8; Isaiah 53:9).

6. How to respond to the Resurrection (Matthew 28:1-10; Romans 1:4).
 - A. You are urged to Believe.

 - B. You are told to tell others (share the Good News)!

 - C. Live out of your hope in Christ by rejoicing.

7. The Gospel confronts you to choose to believe or suppress the application of Jesus' death for you (Matthew 28:11-17).
